VESSEL CRIME PREVENTION:

- Record all details of your boat and equipment.
- Engrave all valuable items with your boat or drivers licence number.
- Fit an anti theft device to your trailer and a quality lock to your boat.
- Consider fitting an alarm to your boat.
- Remove valuable items from your boat when unattended.
- If you are leaving your vehicle parked on shore, ensure you leave no valuables behind and your vehicle is locked and secured.

REPORTING A STOLEN VESSEL:

- To make a stolen vessel report, contact the Police Assistance Line (PAL) - 131 444. In an emergency, contact 000.
- When your vessel is recovered it is important that you do not touch anything. Specialist Police Officers may have to examine the surfaces of the vessel and the vessel's contents for evidence.
