FIREARMS PERMIT TRANQUILLISER AUTHORITY AND CONDITIONS

*Firearm types which apply:
A firearm designed for use in tranquillising, immobilising or
administering vaccines or other medicines to animals.*

Authority

This permit authorises the permit holder to possess and use a firearm designed for use in tranquillising, immobilising or administering vaccines or other medicines to animals in the normal course of the person's occupation.

This permit does not authorise the possession or use of ammunition.

The authority conferred by this permit is subject to the *Firearms Act 1996* and the Regulation and all the General Legislative Requirements applicable to a firearm permit holder¹ apply to this permit in addition to the conditions outlined below.

Conditions:

1. A category A or B firearm authorised by this permit must be stored in compliance with the safe storage requirements prescribed by section 40 of the *Firearms Act 1996*².
2. A category C, D or H firearm authorised by this permit must be stored in compliance with the safe storage requirements prescribed by section 41 of the *Firearms Act 1996*³.
3. The permit holder must ensure the safety of the public at all times when the tranquilliser firearm is used.

Authorised firearms

A firearm designed for use in tranquillising, immobilising or administering vaccines or other medicines to animals.
