To be considered for the program all applicants must have a recognised qualification. The level of the qualification differs according to business unit.

- **Crime Scene Services Branch**
 - Forensic Science degree from a recognised tertiary institution
 - Consideration may be given to degrees in natural sciences such as Chemistry, Physics and Biology studies.
- **Fingerprint Operations**
 - Forensic Science degree from a recognised tertiary institution.
 - Consideration may be given to degrees in natural sciences such as Chemistry, Physics and Biology studies.
 - Holder of Australasian Forensic Science Assessment Body (AFSAB) certification in Fingerprints.
 - Consideration may be given to International Association for Identification (IAI) certification.
- **Ballistics Investigation Section**
 - Forensic Science degree from a recognised tertiary institution.
 - Natural Science degree from a recognised tertiary institution. (Physics, Chemistry, Biology)
 - Engineering – Mechanical degree from a recognised tertiary institution.
 - Engineering – Mechanical trade (fitting/machining) or substantial relevant industry experience.
 - Holder of Australasian Forensic Science Assessment Body (AFSAB) certification in Forensic Firearms.
 - Consideration may be given to those who have significantly progressed through the National Training Curriculum but have not yet attained AFSAB certification.
