Victims Services, within the Department of Communities and Justice, provides counselling and financial assistance to help victims of violent crime in NSW under the Victims Support Scheme .

- 2. Financial assistance for immediate needs, including the Immediate Needs Support Package [INSP] for domestic violence victims
- 3. Financial assistance for economic loss
- 4. 4. Recognition payments.
