### Point 1 – Number of firearm theft incidents

Note: The incidents making up the number of incidents comprise of all stealing incidents in which at least one firearm was stolen. These incidents are made up of “Stealing”, “Robbery” and “Break and Enter” Incident types but do not contain incidents of seized firearms (e.g. domestic violence related firearms seizure) or firearms reported as lost.

### Point 3 - Number of firearms stolen per incident

The information includes as far as recorded in COPS the description of the firearm type stolen and the category. The table breaks the numbers down for each firearms description type used in COPS as well as providing the number of incidents for each year.
