have a speech difficulty.

Call Triple Zero **000** with TTY **or** Speak and Listen. Your call gets answered fast.



TTY users call 106.

To ask for police type PPP.

TTY users must register with the National

Relay Service.



Speak and Listen users call 1800 555 727.

Ask for Triple Zero 000.



Internet Relay users call Triple Zero 000. This call is not a priority over other calls. This means we do not know you

have an emergency.
